# What the APCA Launch Means for Physicians

Physicians holding or seeking the RPVI, RPVI-China, RMSK, CBNC and CBCCT certifications as well as physicians within the Latin American Ultrasound Certificate Program have been transitioned to APCA. Additionally, as APCA is a companion council to ARDMS, physicians holding the ARDMS-awarded RDMS, RDCS and RVT sonographer-level certifications will now manage and maintain these certifications through APCA. The APCA website (www.APCA.org) and secure online portal (MY APCA) are the resources for physicians to apply, prepare for, and maintain both their APCA and ARDMS certifications.

APCA is governed by a physician-led volunteer Council fully committed to the development of assessments and the advancement of patient care. The APCA Council will also identify new areas of practice that would benefit from assessment programs. All APCA examinations are managed by Assessment Oversight Teams made up of physician volunteers who are subject matter experts. APCA Council Chair, Luciana Young, MD, states: "I'm excited to be a part of APCA and help guide it into the future as we continue to meet the needs of physicians and work to advance patient care through excellence in diagnostic medical imaging."

APCA and ARDMS are part of a family of certification councils under the new umbrella organization, Inteleos. Dale Cyr, Inteleos CEO explains, "Creating APCA expresses our commitment to the physician community and to helping them further establish standards in public safety."
